### **Ordinance No. 1993-0501**

#### **AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANIMALS FROM CREATING A NUISANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hartsburg, Illinois:

##### **Section 1. Nuisance Animals Prohibited**

No person owning, possessing, or harboring any dog, cat, or other pet animal within the Village shall permit such animal to become a nuisance.

An animal shall be considered a nuisance if it:

- Substantially damages property other than that of its owner.
- Creates unsanitary, dangerous, or unreasonably offensive conditions.
- Causes disturbances by excessive barking, caterwauling, or other noisemaking.
- Chases vehicles or molests, attacks, or interferes with persons or domestic animals while off the owner's property.

##### **Section 2. Penalty**

Any person found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be fined as follows:

- Ten dollars (\$10.00) for the first violation.
- Twenty dollars (\$20.00) for the second violation within twelve (12) months.
- Forty dollars (\$40.00) for the third violation within twelve (12) months.
- Fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the fourth violation within twelve (12) months.
- One hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each additional violation within the same twelve (12) month period.

##### **Section 3. Effective Date**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
